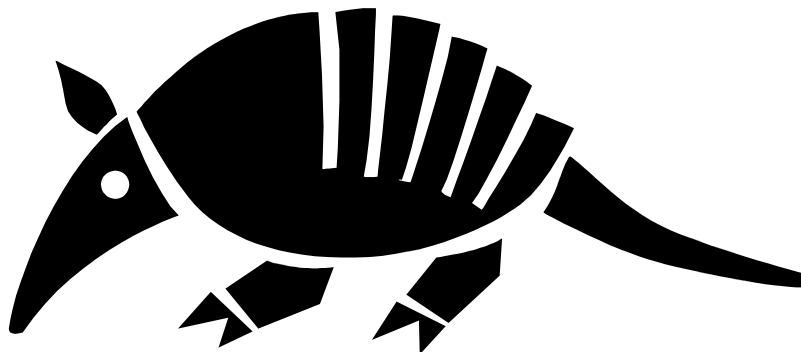

The School Choice application process & important dates

To enroll your child in a school other than your neighborhood school for 2008-09, follow this process:

- Starting in January 2008, pick up an application at any school, at the 4J Education Center, 200 North Monroe Street, or online at www.4j.lane.edu
- Research or visit school programs; schools hold open houses, information nights and other events during the weeks of Jan. 28–31, 2008 & Feb. 25–29, 2008.
- Return the application no later than March 21 to the 4J Education Center.
- When schools have limited openings, students will be accepted based on a lottery conducted at the 4J Education Center; lottery results will be available starting April 4.
- Parents do not need to visit a school for their child to be accepted at that school.
- For the 2007–08 year: Transfers between neighborhood schools and entry into alternative schools is possible as space is available. For transfer information, call 687-3481. For alternative school entry information, please contact alternative schools directly.
