We are requesting that you provide the following personal school supplies. If you need assistance in providing any of the supplies listed below, please let the principal or teacher know. We also encourage you to reuse supplies previously purchased. Experience has shown that some materials, although less expensive, do not work as effectively in the classroom. Where brand names have been suggested, please purchase one of those.

KINDERGARTEN

- 3 Glue Sticks
- 1 set of pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 1 box of 12 colored pencils (Crayola or Prang are best quality)
- 1 box of 8-count crayons (no more, no less) (Crayola or Prang)
- 1 box of 8 thin markers
- Large box of tissues
- Regular sized backpack without wheels (For safety reasons, put child's name on inside of pack, not on outside.)
 - Large enough to hold our homework envelopes
- *Children who attend the YMCA on site child care program should have a separate swim bag on Fridays for wet swimwear. Two separate bags that day.

We share supplies in our classroom community; do not put names on school tools. We may need to request other supplies later.

- 24 #2 **SHARPENED** pencils with erasers
- 2 packages pencil top erasers
- Box of 24 Crayola Crayons
- 1 set 12 Crayola colored pencils **SHARPENED**
- Elmer's white glue, 8 oz.
- 1 Glue stick
- Large box of facial tissues (for class use)*
- School supply box (cigar-box style) - SMALL
- Box of 8 Crayola Big Markers
- Backpack for daily use. Please, no backpacks with wheels!
- 1 pink pearl eraser

GRADE 2

- Two dozen #2 Sharpened pencils*
- Large **box of facial tissue***
- 1 Pink Pearl eraser
- 1 box 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 box of 8 Thin Crayola Markers*
- 6-inch children's scissors
- Prang water colors
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 8oz regular glue
- 1 set 12 Crayola colored pencils (Sharpened)

GRADE 3

24 plain yellow #2 **SHARPENED** pencils with erasers. Please write name or initials on each one.

2 large pink erasers

Box of **24 ONLY** Crayola Crayons. Write name on each one.

Set of watercolor paints (8 in set)

1 glue stick (For class use)

Large box of facial tissues to share

School supply box (**SMALL** cigar-box style)

1 Box unscented, washable markers - wide or narrow. Write name on each one.

1 set colored pencils (12 Crayola) **SHARPENED**. Write name on each one.

1 package wide lined loose leaf notebook paper (for class use)

1 set of notebook dividers (5 in package)
