

Electronic Devices Guidelines

In an effort to make this trip fun for all, the chaperones have set forth some guidelines that we expect all students to follow during the trip. The chaperones, touring company and/or hotel will not be responsible for loss, damage or theft of personal technology brought on the trip by students. Students assume responsibility for all lost, damaged, or stolen personal technology devices. We will not be returning to any location to recover lost items. If at any time an electronic device causes difficulties or distractions, it will be confiscated and given back at a more appropriate time.

1. Please do not bring cell phones!
 - a. All chaperones stand ready to provide access to their personal cell phones for students to make calls home.
2. Portable music players are allowed for bus rides and airplane flights that are longer than one hour.
3. Cameras are allowed on the trip.
 - a. If you choose to bring one, please keep it small, as bulky cameras may get in the way on the many long walks we will take.
 - b. Please avoid taking pictures in areas where individuals expect privacy, i.e. bathrooms and changing areas.
4. Handheld video game devices are allowed for bus rides and airplane flights that are longer than one hour.
5. Larger video game systems and laptops are not allowed on the trip. Please leave these at home.
