

Kelly Site Council Minutes October 8, 2008

Motion to approve minutes (Dustin/Jenny), with the exception of a change regarding the EEF grant. Site Council approved the grants in rank order (Read Right, Registration for National MEChA Conference at U of O, and TRX functional suspension-training). However, because of the response from the district, it was decided that the Read Right grant request would be written for \$2000.00.

- 4) Sell chips and juice after school to donate the funds to the Greenhill and Lane County Animal Shelters. They will also change this according to the wellness policy.

*Motion was made, seconded and approved to approve the ice shavings and the coin drive. *Motion was made, seconded and approved for #3 with the change in food selection. The animal shelter fundraiser was tabled until another time.

Beth Gerot, Eugene 4J School Board, made a presentation about the local option levy renewal that will be on the ballot for the next election. This will NOT increase taxes. This is just a renewal for the current levy.
