No Child Should Go Without Health Services

Since April, **Churchill My School's Health Center** now offers comprehensive health services not only to school district students but to their families as well. A full time Family Nurse Practitioner and a bilingual Medical Assistant provide services year round from 8 – 5 on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. On Tuesdays, the clinic is open from 9 – 6.

The Rodriguez family visited the Health Center last week for treatment of chronic asthma, a sports injury, an ear infection, well child visits and immunizations. The whole family has a good relationship with Carol Matney, the family nurse practitioner, and feels this made all the difference in their care.

Mrs. Rodriguez said, "I don't know what my family would do without the Health Center. The care is so good and it is so easy to access. That's important to us. The kids can go to the Health Center on their own or we can go together. The staff is terrific and they make sure that we get what we need to get healthy and stay healthy. "

If your child does not have health insurance, Carmen Bravo, the bilingual Outreach Specialist will assist families with Oregon Health Plan enrollment. She is available to meet with you at the Churchill Clinic on 1850 Bailey Hill Road or at your school.
