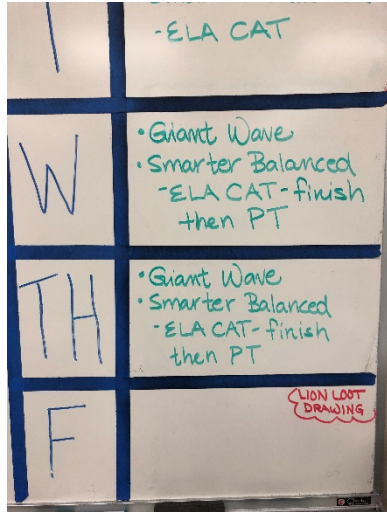

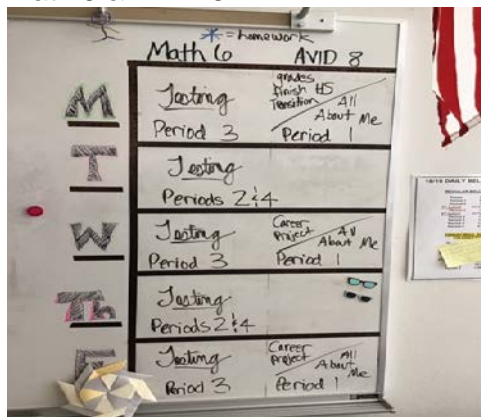

May Focus: How to begin a conversation when meeting Spanish speakers. Strategies to help communicate in Spanish as a beginning language learner. After our final exam we will be moving to an independent Spanish-speaking country research project.

Spanish 1

May Focus: We are finishing our very last unit of the school year, Unidad 3. After the final exam we will be making piñatas in the two weeks that the school is administering the SBAC tests. We will then end the school year with an independent Spanish-speaking country research project, students will be presenting to the whole class.

Spanish 2

May Focus: We have begun Unidad 6 which is the last unit of the school year. In this unit we will be discussing the weather, things that we are currently in the process of doing (-ing), and continue to work on the simple past tense.

Homework: Students should study approximately 20 vocabulary words every night, rotating the words daily. All vocabulary words should be covered over the course of a week and should continue to practice them until the end of the unit.
